

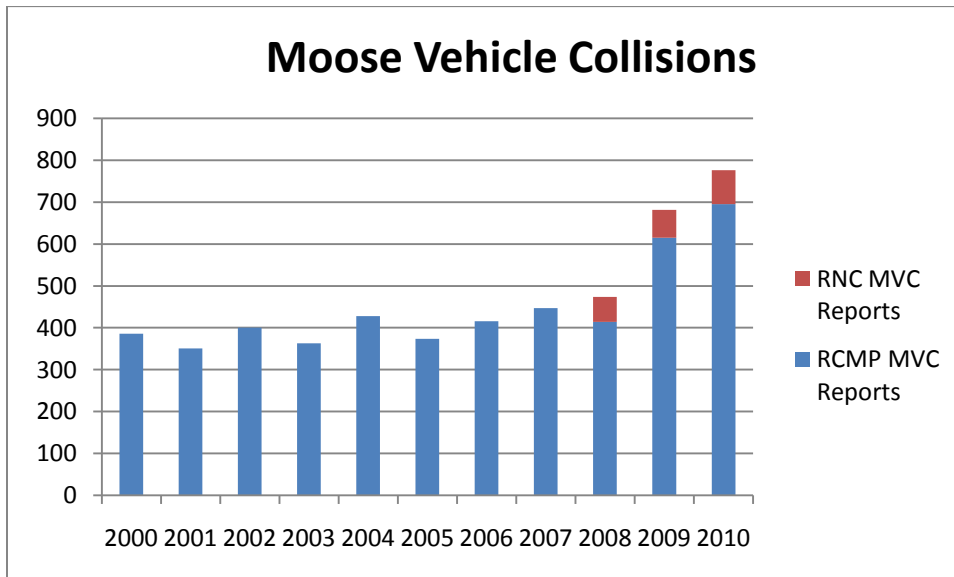

### MOOSE COLLISION FREQUENCY - STOP THE PRESS!

Save Our People Action Committee just this morning received a breakdown from the RCMP of moose vehicle collision reports between 2009 and 2010. These show an unmistakable RISING TREND for moose vehicle collisions in Newfoundland and Labrador.

The risk of hitting a moose has risen over 50% since 2005 and over 40% since 2008. “This is a serious public safety issue which has reached crisis proportions,” said Eugene Nippard, President of the SOPAC, a moose vehicle lobby group. “It will only get worse with continued government inaction.”
