This is to confirm that, on January 14th, 2011, the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary received your request for access to the following records/information:


"... Please provide the number of moose-vehicle collisions reported to the RNC for the years 1995-2010..."

The attached information was obtained from data reviewed on 2010-11-08 and 2011-01-27 from the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary's in-house computer system, the Integrated Constabulary Automated Network (ICAN). In particular, this information was obtained by reviewing the Call for Service type of General Occurrence on the Record Management System (RMS) components of the ICAN system. The purpose of the CAD System is to record calls for service and police response, data collected will not necessarily determine whether or not a complaint was founded or unfounded.

Statistical information for 2010 has not been verified for accuracy by the RNC and Statistics Canada.
